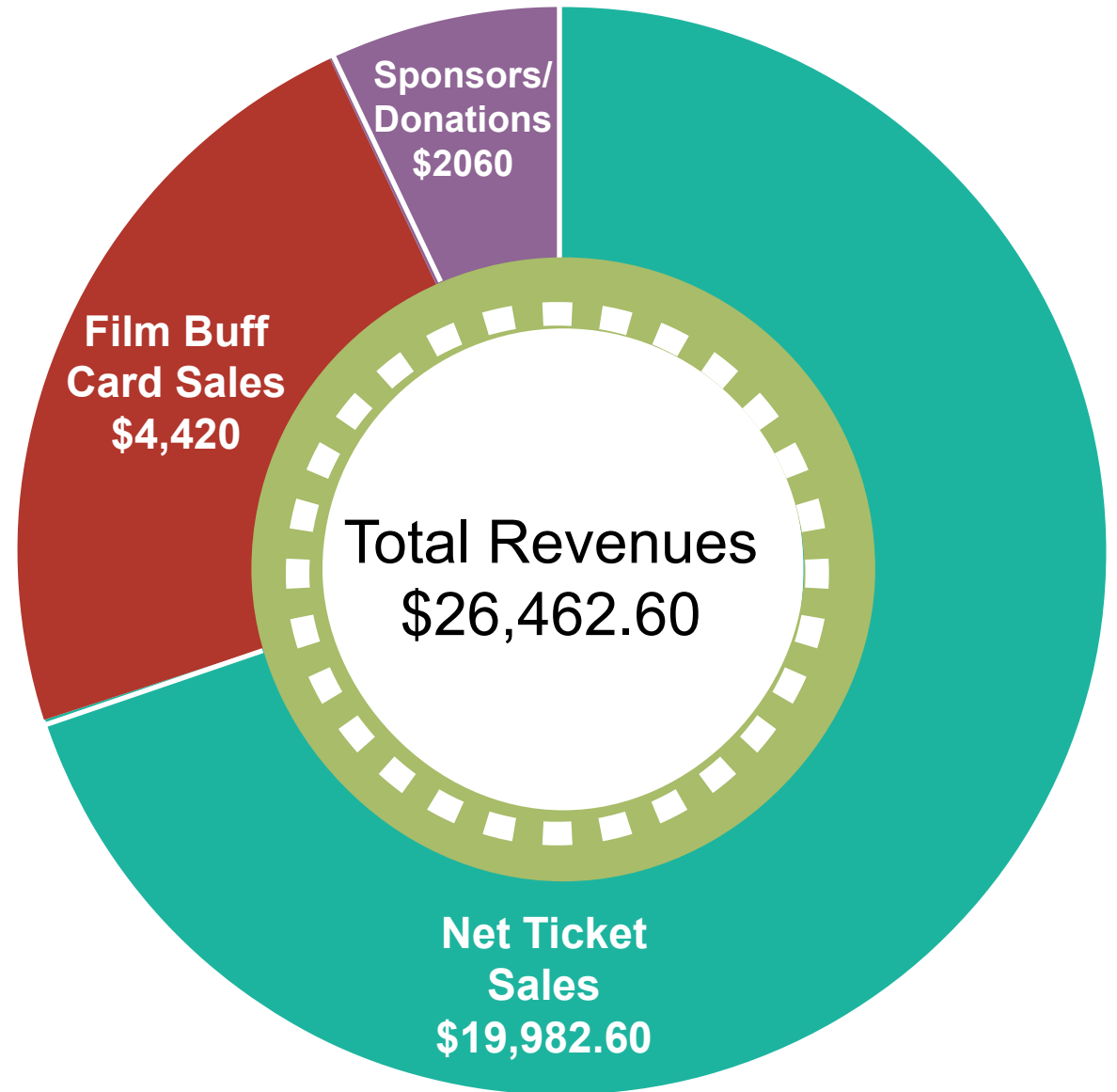
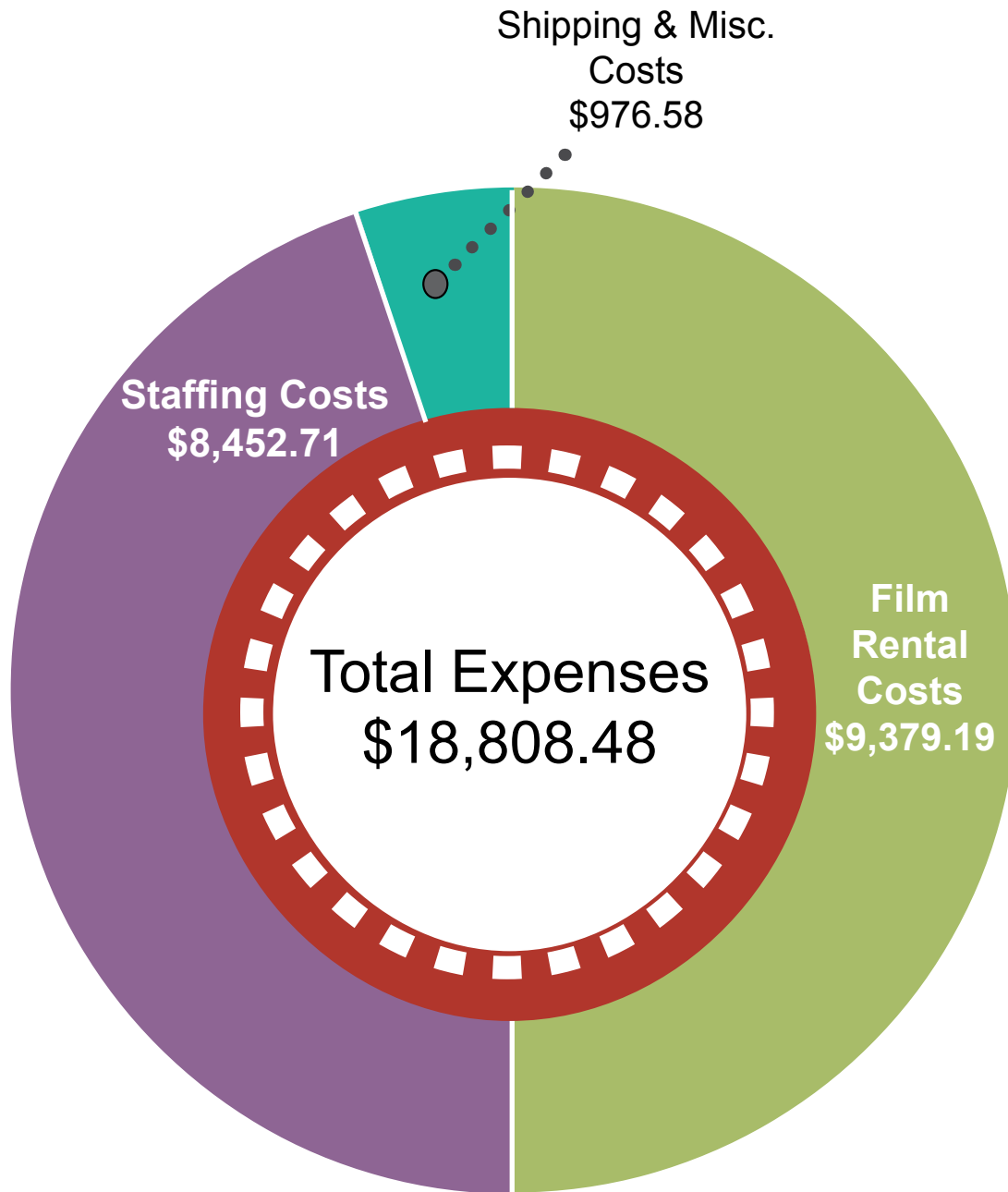


King's Film Society Annual Report 2018
